## Zanzibar

### STAY

Dotted along the powder-white northern shores of Unguja island, Zuri Zanzibar (1) is a clutch of thatched wooden hideouts, each one tucked away in its own pocket of jungle and reached via a labyrinth of lantern-lit walkways. The interiors showcase a mix of rattan, warm wood and linen, with furniture upcycled from old dhows, and on the terraces you'll find hammocks and squishy loungers. The vibe on the silk-sanded beach (non-tidal – a rarity in this part of the world) is relaxed. Elsewhere, there's a spice garden and an alfresco library.

### TASTE

Tuck into garlicky king prawns and red snapper ceviche at popular lunch spot The Jetty, or bag a seat beneath a thatched parasol at lively Cholo's Bar, where fresh sushi is the order of the day. At Zuri Zanzibar, laid-back Upendo (3) dishes up inventive twists on international classics, and the guys behind the bar at Peponi mix a mean G&T. If you're keen to

make the most of the setting, staff can arrange candlelit beach dinners, with your own bonfire to boot.

### INDULGE

Perfect your sun salutations with an energising dawn session on Zuri Zanzibar's yoga deck – those Indian Ocean views will send your spirit soaring – or ease away tension with a deep tissue massage at Maua Wellness.

### EXPLORE

Lassoed by blindingly white beaches, Zanzibar makes a glorious backdrop for a week of unwinding, though the warm turquoise waters offer no end of exhilarating experiences, from snorkelling to kitesurfing. Consider a diving trip to Mnemba Atoll marine park, where coral abounds and green turtle and dolphin encounters are commonplace. Or head out on a sunset dhow cruise (2), soundtrack by soulful taarab beats, to watch the sky turn electric peach above the ocean.
